**NOTICE OF HOLIDAY WORK**

In an effort to remain on schedule the City of New Orleans construction contractor, Impetus Infrastructure, LLC, has been granted permission to work on The Anniversary of Hurricane Katrina. They will be performing the following:

**Water line tie-ins:**

- Plum St (Hillary St- Lowerline St)
- Oak St (Hillary St- Cherokee St)

**Drainage tie-in:**

- Adams St (Birch St- Jeannette St)

**Roadway removal:**

- Birch St (Lowerline St- Adams St)

**WHEN: *Friday, August 29, 2025 from 8AM-5PM***

**For residents impacted by the water tie in when water is restored, run your faucets for 5 minutes to flush out the lines before resuming regular use.**

If water is not restored within one hour on Friday, August 29th residents will be contacted by Office of Strategic Engagement and Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans via text messaging alert and/or community canvassing.

**About the Project**

This work is part of \$28.7M East Carrollton Group B and C joint infrastructure project with the City of New Orleans' Department of Public Works and Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans.

Once complete, residents will experience an overall improved quality of life as the project will improve drainage, repair streets, curbs and sidewalks and install new Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)-compliant curb ramps at intersections. The project is scheduled to be completed in Winter 2025
