



Gentilly Terrace North Group B Project Update – January 2025 Community Update

The **Gentilly Terrace North Group B** joint infrastructure construction projects with the City of New Orleans' Department of Public Works and Sewerage and Water Board are performing adjacent construction work in your neighborhood. The intention of this community update is to provide you with an overall picture of the ongoing work around you.

What work is currently happening on Gentilly Terrace North Group B?

- **4500 – 4600 Western St.** – The crews are working on prepping this block to undergo asphalt preparation. This work is expected to be completed in the next few weeks.
- **Mirabeau Ave. and Western St. (intersection)** - The crews are working on forming, placing steel in roadway restoration.
- **Lombard St. and Spain St.** – The crews are working on pavement restoration, sidewalks, driveways, and ADA ramps. This work is expected to be completed in the next few weeks.
- **Filmore Ave. and St. Roch Ave** - The crews are working on laying down asphalt. This work is expected to be completed in the next few weeks.
- **Filmore Ave. and Arts St** - The crews are working on laying down asphalt. This work is expected to be completed in the next few weeks.
- **Filmore Ave. and Venus St** - The crews are working on laying down asphalt. This work is expected to be completed in the next few weeks.
- **4400 St. Roch Ave** - The crews are working on forming, placing steel and pouring concrete for curb and gutter. This work is expected to be completed by March 2025.
- **Carnot St. and St. Roch Ave.** – The crews are working on building catch basin and adjust castings. This work is expected to be completed in the next few weeks.

When will each project be complete?

- **Gentilly Terrace Group B** – They expect to reach substantial completion by the end of May 2025.

About the Projects

This work is a part of the **\$37.9M Gentilly Terrace North Group B** joint infrastructure projects with the City of New Orleans' Department of Public Works and Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans.

Once complete, residents will experience an overall improved quality of life as the project will improve drainage, repair streets, curbs and sidewalks and install new Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)-compliant curb ramps at intersections.
