NOTICE OF HOLIDAY WORK

The City of New Orleans construction contractor, Hard Rock Construction, LLC, will be continuing with utility repair work on Monday's City Holiday to remain on schedule.

WHEN: *Monday, October 9th, 2023, 7 a.m. – 5:30 p.m.*

WHERE: *4600 block of Demontluzin St
4700 block of Lafaye St
4400 block of St. Roch Ave
5100 block of St. Roch Ave / Dreux St intersection
5200 block of Arts St
5300 block of Venus St*

During this time there will be large trucks and heavy equipment hauling materials in the area. Public safety is our priority; residents and commuters are reminded to use caution when driving, bicycling and walking near the construction site.

About the Project

This weekend work is part of the **\$37.9M Gentilly Terrace North Group B** joint infrastructure project with the City of New Orleans' Department of Public Works and Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans.

Once complete, residents will experience an overall improved quality of life as the project will improve drainage, repair streets, curbs and sidewalks and install new Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)-compliant curb ramps at intersections. The project is scheduled to be completed in Spring of 2025.
