### NOTICE OF HOLIDAY WORK

In an effort to remain on schedule the City of New Orleans construction contractors, C&M & Wallace C. Drennan, have been granted permission to work on Martin Luther King Jr Day. They will be working on prepping for asphalt pour on Desire Drive, converting a catch basin into a rollover on Gallier Avenue, and fixing a water leak on Pauline Drive.

**WHEN:** *January 20, 2025, 7:00 AM to 5:30 PM*

**WHERE:** Desire Drive (Mirabeau Ave to Stephen Girard Ave)  
Gallier Drive (Mirabeau Ave to Stephen Girard Ave)  
Pauline Drive at Mirabeau Ave

During this time there will be large trucks and heavy equipment hauling materials in the area. Public safety is our priority; residents and commuters are reminded to use caution when driving, bicycling and walking near the construction site.

#### About the Project

This work is part of the **\$48.1M Gentilly Woods Group F** joint infrastructure project with the City of New Orleans' Department of Public Works and Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans.

Once complete, residents will experience an overall improved quality of life as the project will improve drainage, repair streets, curbs and sidewalks and install new American with Disabilities Act (ADA)-compliant curb ramps at intersections. The project is scheduled to be completed in the 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter of 2025.
