NOTICE OF SERVICE DISRUPTION

**** WATER ****

You may experience low or no water pressure in this area.
During this time, please find an alternative water supply.

The City of New Orleans Department of Public Works' contractor Infinity Construction & Trucking, in conjunction with the Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans, will be performing a water tie-in.

WHEN: *Thursday, May 22, 2025, 8:30 AM – 5:30 PM*

WHERE: *Ring Street (Canal Blvd to Allen Toussaint Blvd)
Gem Street (Ring St to Sardonyx Street)
Allen Toussaint Blvd. (W-Bound) (Ring St to General Haig St.)*

When water is restored, run your faucets for 5 minutes to flush out the lines before resuming regular use.

If water is not restored within one hour of listed end time, residents will be contacted by the Office of Strategic Engagement and Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans via text messaging alert and/or community canvassing.

About the Project

This temporary disruption of services is part of the **\$2.4M Lakeshore Group E** joint infrastructure project with the City of New Orleans' Department of Public Works and Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans.

Once complete, residents will experience an overall improved quality of life as the project will improve drainage, repair streets, curbs and sidewalks and install new Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)-compliant curb ramps at intersections. The project is scheduled to be completed in the Summer of 2025.
