

Community Update – September 2023 Marlyville-Fontainebleau Group A

Marlyville-Fontainebleau Group A is a project in both the Marlyville and Fontainebleau neighborhoods. The project spans across approximately 140-blocks with 24 blocks being full reconstruction of the roadway and subsurface utility work.

Temporary inconveniences do tend to accompany infrastructure upgrades; however, in this case, the delays and access issues have been excessive. In recent months, leaders from the City Infrastructure Team have been conducting site visits and working closely with the combined Sewerage and Water Board New Orleans (SWBNO) / Department of Public Works (DPW) project management and construction contractor team. We are committed to holding all members of the team accountable to finding solutions for the issues holding up construction, as well as to getting this work completed with an improved quality of life for the community. Following is an update and path forward on completing this project without anymore excessive delays by the anticipated fall 2024 end date.

Project Outlook

Due to delays on this project crews will continue to work some weekends to meet critical deadlines outlined in this update. *Residents will be notified ahead of any weekend work.*

Below is a project update provided by the RR116 Team:

Utilities on the 7000 block of Walmsley are anticipated to be done in September. Roadway restoration will follow. This is expected to take 4-6 weeks. Please continue to bring trash cans to the nearest accessible corner as we complete the roadway. Utility work on 2400 Adams and 2200 Short currently is currently in process. Roadway restoration continues on 7800 Panola St., 8000 Spruce St., 3000 Short St., 3000 Fern St. Sidewalks and driveway work will occur on 2100 Lowerline St. 7400-7800 Spruce once designs have been completed. Hard Rock will start this work upon approval of the designs.

This **\$26.8M** Marlyville-Fontainebleau Group A project was designed by Schrenk, Endom & Flanagan and is being constructed by Hard Rock Construction. The scope of work varies block by block but includes the following:

- Repaving the asphalt roadway from curb-to-curb
- · Replacing damaged portions of concrete with new concrete
- Patching the roadway with asphalt, repairing damaged sidewalks and driveway aprons
- Installing ADA compliant curb ramps at intersections
- Replacing/repairing damaged underground water, sewer and/or drainage lines
