The City of New Orleans construction contractor, **Wallace C. Drennan**, will be performing clean-up work and completing punch list items during a designated city holiday (Indigenous Peoples' Day) in an effort to remain on schedule.

During this time there will be large trucks and heavy equipment hauling materials in the area. Public safety is our priority; residents and commuters are reminded to use caution when driving, bicycling and walking near the construction site.

About the Project

This weekend work is part of the **\$10.5M Marlyville-Fontainebleau Group C** joint infrastructure project with the City of New Orleans' Department of Public Works and Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans.

Once complete, residents will experience an overall improved quality of life as the project will improve drainage, repair streets, curbs and sidewalks and install new Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)-compliant curb ramps at intersections. The project is scheduled to be completed in **Fall 2023**.
