



Community Update – September 2023

Plum Orchard Group C

The Plum Orchard Group C project (RR136) began in September of 2022. Plum Orchard Group C includes a total of 9-blocks. Most of the repairs conducted under this project are considered full reconstruction, where crews repair/replace subsurface utilities, roadway, sidewalks, and Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) curb ramps.

Temporary inconveniences do tend to accompany infrastructure upgrades. In recent months, leaders from the City Infrastructure Team have been conducting site visits and working closely with the combined Sewerage and Water Board New Orleans (SWBNO) / Department of Public Works (DPW) project management and construction contractor team. We are committed to holding all members of the team accountable to finding solutions for the issues holding up construction, as well as to getting this work completed with an improved quality of life for the community. Following is an update and path forward on completing this project with minimal delays by the anticipated spring 2024 end date.

30-Day Forecast

Due to delays on this project crews will continue to work some weekends to meet critical deadlines outlined in this update. **Residents will continue to be notified ahead of any weekend work.**

The Department of Public Works (DPW) and Roubion Roads and Streets, LLC. will continue working in the following areas over the next month:

- Sewer line point repairs on 4700 block of Eastview Drive
- Waterline installation on 4600 block of Eastview Drive
- Sewer line point repairs on 4800 block of Eastview Drive
- Pavement work on other half of 4900 block of Eastview Drive

This **\$4.4M** Plum Orchard Group C project began in September 2022. The project was designed by Burk-Kleinpeter, Inc. and is being constructed by Roubion Roads and Streets, LLC. The scope of work varies block by block but includes the following:

- Replacement of damaged underground water, sewer and drainage lines
- Repaving the roadway
- Repairing/Replacing damaged sidewalks and driveway aprons
- Installing Americans with Disabilities Act-compliant curb ramps at intersections.
