NOTICE OF HOLIDAY WORK

The City of New Orleans Department of Public Works' contractor Impetus Construction, LLC., will be performing drainage installation, roadway replacement, and sidewalk/driveway removal/replacement on Monday's City Holiday to remain on schedule.

WHEN: *Monday, October 9, 2023, from 7:00 a.m. – 5:30 p.m.*

WHERE: *4700–4800 Bright Drive
11300-11400 Prentiss Avenue*

During this time there will be large trucks and heavy equipment hauling materials in the area. Public safety is our priority; residents and commuters are reminded to use caution when driving, bicycling, and walking near the construction site.

About the Project

This holiday work is part of the **\$9.5M Read Blvd East Group F** joint infrastructure project with the City of New Orleans' Department of Public Works and Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans.

Once complete, residents will experience an overall improved quality of life as the project will replace/repair damaged underground water, sewer and/or drainage lines, replace damaged portions of concrete with new concrete, repair damaged sidewalks and driveway aprons, and install Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)-compliant curb ramps at intersections. The project is scheduled to be completed in the Fall of 2023.
