SWBNO / DPW Joint Infrastructure Program Accomplishments

- December 2015: \$2B FEMA Settlement for Hurricane Katrina-related damage to roads and subsurface infrastructure
- May 7, 2018: 10 JIRR projects in construction
- Since May 7, 2018
 - ✓ 85 projects totaling **\$851M** have gone into construction
 - ✓ 56 projects completed, totaling **\$379M**
 - ✓ 129 projects have gone into final design, **totaling \$1B**
- Current Status with estimated values
 - ✓ **Construction:** 46 Projects, **\$546M**
 - ✓ **Bid & Award:** 24 Projects, **\$153M**
 - ✓ **Final Design:** 72 Projects, **\$510M**
 - ✓ **Completed:** 56 projects, **\$379M**



Project Overview:

- **Design:** Urban Systems
- **Construction:** Murphy Pipeline Construction, LLC
- **Construction Cost:** Approximately \$8.6M Project
- **Timeline:** Project will begin November 2022 and will be completed in Summer 2023

Sewer, Water and Drain line Replacements or Repairs



- Water service disruptions notifications will be sent to residents 48-hours prior to full water closures and 24-hours before test closures.

Sidewalks

- Sidewalk panels adjacent to Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)-compliant ramps will be replaced with new sidewalks.
- New sidewalks and ramps will meet ADA-compliance regulations.



Americans with Disabilities Act-Compliant Curb Ramps



Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)-compliant curb ramps at sidewalk corners ensure accessibility for people who are visually or physically impaired, using wheelchairs or strollers.



Construction Phasing:

- ✓ Construction will be completed utilizing a Task Order system.
- ✓ The Construction Team will work on set number of task, complete the current task, and then mobilize to begin the next phase of task orders.
- ✓ The Task Order system is in place to minimize the impact sustained by the community.

What to Expect During Construction

Temporary construction impacts

- Additional construction equipment –
 - **Staging for this project has yet to be determined.**
- Limited parking availability
- Sounds
- Dust and debris

Efforts to minimize construction impacts

- Construction signage placed around the sites.
- Any temporary closures will be communicated in advance.
- Construction equipment will not be staged in areas that prohibit residential access and parking.
- We ask residents to move garbage and recycling to open intersections of the block when construction is underway.
- Please contact our offices if there is a change in your postal delivery or sanitation pickup.
- Residents will be informed throughout construction.

Permission for occasional weekend work may be granted, if required.
